PERSONAL EQUIPMENT LIST



Required:

Camp hat

Full uniform i.e. shirt, sash, woggle & neckerchief

2 extra t-shirts

2 pair pants - sweat pants are best

4 extra pair socks

2-3 changes of underwear

Toque and warm gloves or mitts

Warm coat, splash pants and boots - in case of wet weather

Hiking boots or shoes suitable for Hiking

Raincoat

Sweater or heavy sweatshirt

Pajamas or sweat pants to sleep in

Adequate sleeping bag - **3rd year Cubs will be sleeping outdoors in tents**

1/2 inch thick blue foam mattress or self inflating air mattress

Plastic bag for dirty clothes

Hand towel and face cloth

Toothbrush and toothpaste

Comb or brush

Flashlight + extra batteries

One dozen cookies or squares of any kind - **please list ingredients as some youths have allergies – absolutely no nuts.**

Mess kit, plate and bowl, cup (unbreakable) knife, fork and spoon

Cub or Scout Book

Optional

Pillow

Campfire blanket

All items should be clearly marked with the Youth's full name. Items should be packed in plastic bags and then placed in backpacks or carrying bags (i.e. large sport tote bag). Suitcases are not recommended as it could be quite a walk from parking areas to the cabins or tent area.

Knives will not be allowed for Beavers and Cubs. Scouts can bring knives if their Section Scouter approves. No knives will be allowed at the "Scouts Own" or the "Formal Campfire" sites. Only folding knives are allowed.

Kit checks will be done before leaving for camp at the departure site.

Absolutely not allowed

Do not bring candy, gum or treats of any kind for the youth's personal use. Youth will be provided with all they need to eat.

Money, radios or hand held video games of any kind.
